# SCHOLARSHIPS

**Kickstart Scholarship** - Awarded to students who have demonstrated a high level of academic achievement and overall commitment to studies. Eligibility - Students who complete a 2 years vocational course. Upto \$2000.

**Loyola Access Scholarship** - Awarded to current and prospective students who have experienced hardship, disability or any other form of disadvantage. Eligibility - Available for all courses. Upto \$1000.

**Cont-Ed Scholarship** - Awarded to students who have completed at least a year in one of our courses and have demonstrated a high level of academic achievement and overall commitment to studies. Eligibility - Current students who continue their study with us. Upto \$2000.

**Higher Education Scholarship** - Awarded to students with a high performance track record and who choose to study in our higher education pathway.
